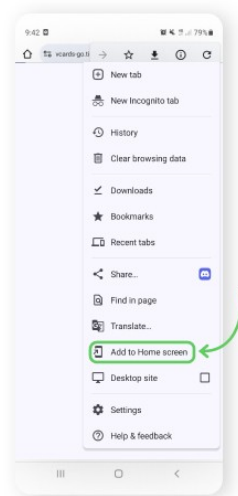

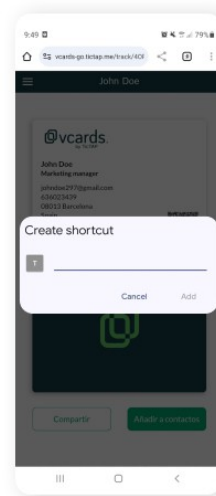
Adding your vcard to the home screen of your smartphone is the easiest way to access it directly. Follow these simple steps to add your vcard from Android or iOS devices:

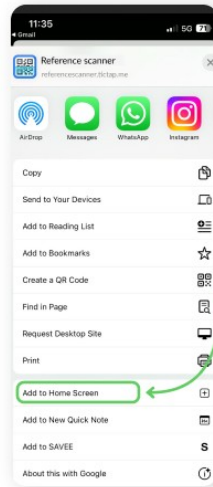

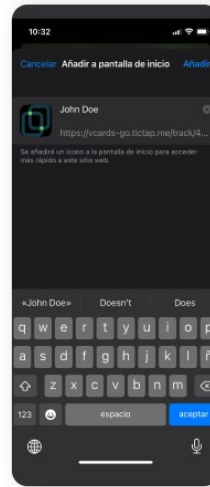

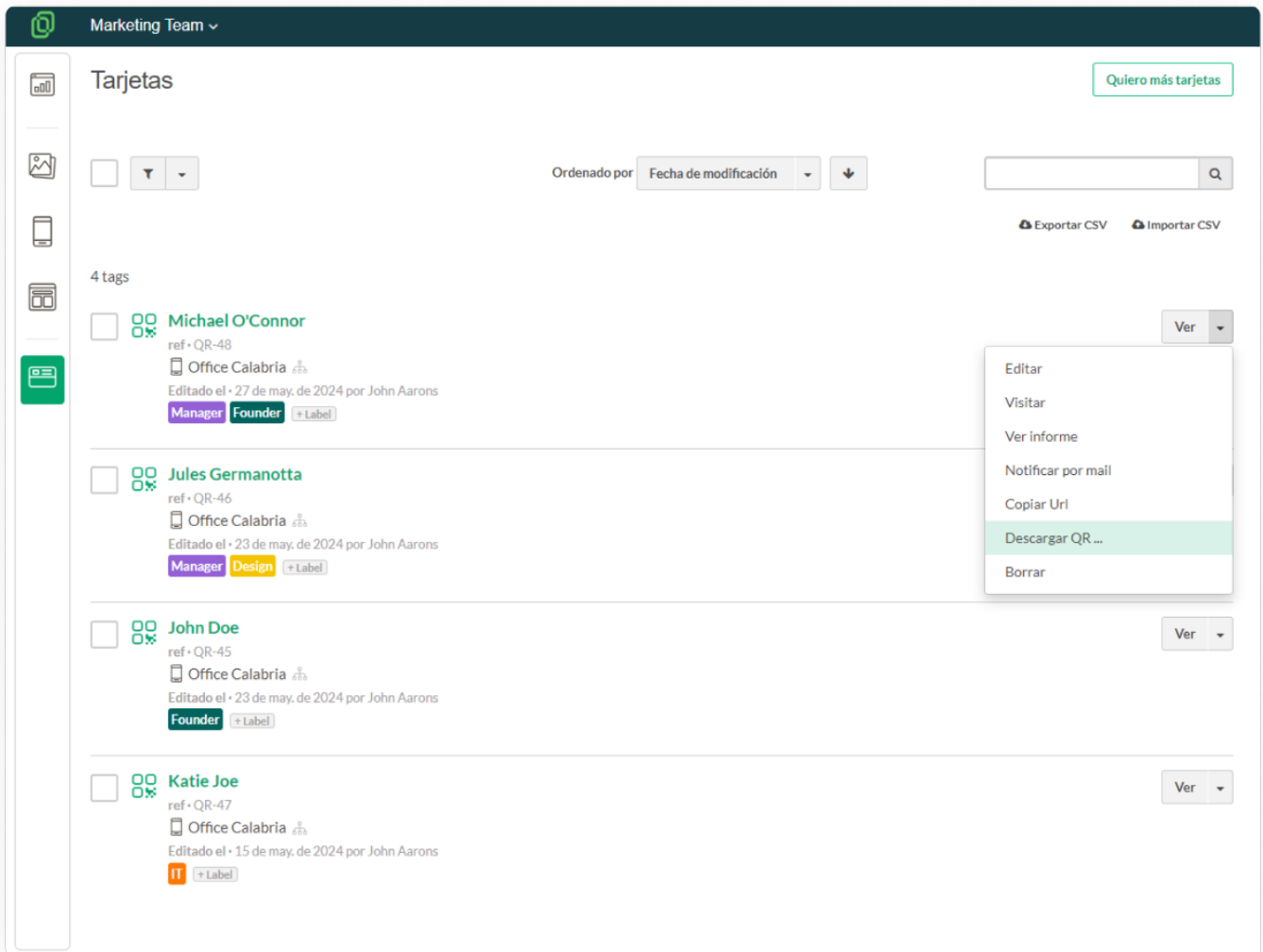

Can I attach my vcard in my email signature?

For example, if you own the domain **my-company.com**, you could access your vcards under any subdomain, such as **vcards.my-company.com**. On your end, you would only need to create an entry in your DNS service as follows.

```
type: CNAME
name: vcards.my-company.com
value: vcards-go.tictap.me
```

After making this change, you will need to notify us that you wish to use your own subdomain so we can update the URLs of your cards.
